

University Entrance Requirements

Applicants are normally required to complete Grade 12 studies on a full-time basis in high school, have one of the following qualifications and meet the English language requirement. Due to quota limit, applicants will be considered for admission on a competitive basis. Holding minimum requirement does not guarantee admission to the University.
