# APPLICATION PROCESS for 2023 (tentative)

March/April (First Stage)	<b>Submit Application Form</b> •Please make sure all documents required are in order prior to submission.		
May/June (Second & Third Stage)	<ul> <li>Written Examination &amp; Interview</li> <li>Only candidates who meet the minimum requirement will be called for written examination.</li> <li>Only successful candidates will be called for interview.</li> </ul>		
Aug (Fourth Stage)	<b>Nomination</b> •Postgraduate candidates should submit Letter of Acceptance (LOA) issued by Japanese universities to the Embassy by end of Sept.		
Dec	<b>Final Result</b> •Candidates get result of nomination – whether they are tentatively selected as scholarship recipients or not		
Feb (next year)	<b>University Placement Result</b> •Candidates get to know university placement result and confirmed as scholarship recipients.
