The history of our school began with the establishment of Chong Hwa Setapak in 1919, making this its 105th anniversary. In conjunction with the anniversary, various activities have been held throughout the year, such as the 105th School Anniversary (21 March), Chong Hwa Forum (1) – Healthy Eating (4 May), the 2nd Malaysia Harmonica Festival (27–29 May), CHKL Open Day (7–8 June), Minggu Bahasa Kebangsaan (24–28 June), Higher Education Exhibition (4–5 July), Charity Fair (31 August), Chong Hwa Forum (2) – Career Counselling Talk (7 September), and the musical play, ROOT, (13 September). Today's 105th Anniversary Dinner not only serves as a celebration, it also aims to raise funds for the school construction project.

Our school is renowned for its excellent culture and outstanding students. In 1981, the school relocated to Jalan Ipoh in Kuala Lumpur. Over the past 40 years, the nine-acre school grounds has undergone extensive development and is now operating at full capacity. At this juncture, Sime Darby Property Berhad has allocated 10 acres of land in City of Elmina for education purposes. Our school board has obtained approval for the construction of our new school branch – Sekolah Menengah Akademik Chong Hwa, Elmina City – on this plot of land. This will be completed within a designated time frame.

The school has been actively raising funds for the construction of the new branch. Its establishment will not only expand Chinese education locally but also extend the excellent teaching tradition of Chong Hwa Independent High School, Kuala Lumpur (CHKL). The branch will continue to uphold the school motto of "Courtesy, Righteousness, Integrity, and A Sense of Shame", emphasising 12 competencies across four key areas, creating a community that blends humanity and technology. This will enable the new generation to become future leaders who serve the nation and the world with a broad vision!
