In this modern era, a growing number of Malaysians are opting to send their children to receive Chinese education. Currently, there are eight Chinese independent high schools in Selangor and Kuala Lumpur, with more than 8,000 students applying each year. Due to the limited space on campus, only about 50% or roughly 4,000 applicants are admitted as Junior Middle One students. Each year, hundreds of students who apply to Chong Hwa Independent High School Kuala Lumpur (CHKL) are turned away.

Since the relocation of CHKL from Jalan Gombak to Jalan Ipoh in 1981, the school has flourished with its students performing excellently and receiving widespread praise. Over the past 40 years, in order to keep up with the times, the Board of Directors has worked diligently to develop more conducive space. CHKL has been successfully expanded and added new buildings, including classrooms, administrative buildings and hostels, which allows students to thrive and succeed. As of 2020, there were already 10 buildings on campus. By the end of 2024, the Extracurricular Activity Centre will have been completed. Thereafter, the development of the current campus will reach its full capacity, and the further development of the school will rest upon new opportunities that arise.

In the spirit of giving back to society, the well-known public listed company, Sime Darby Property Berhad has recently donated a ten-acre plot of land in City of Elmina to CHKL for the establishment of its affiliated school. The Board of Directors has successfully persevered through applications and negotiations to secure the approval from the authorities to develop this affiliated school within a specific time frame.

The affiliated school, Sekolah Menengah Akademik Chong Hwa, City of Elmina will not only allow more students to complete their secondary education, but also continue the CHKL's educational philosophy of preserving and promoting Chinese culture and education. It will also fully implement the CHKL's motto of "Courtesy, Righteousness, Integrity and Conscientiousness" and provide students a conducive learning environment. In line with the CHKL's Educational Development Blueprint, the affiliated school will also emphasise on the four aspects and twelve core qualities, cultivating talents and producing students who will become pillars of the nation and society.
